Sunday 7 May

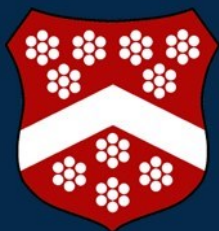
Do you remember the Big Screen from New Years Eve? What a great night that was!
